ICEAP to Celebrate 2nd Anniversary, Grand Opening

It was a distant dream for the original workers of ICEAP that two years later they would be standing in their own building about to celebrate their second anniversary with a grand opening. ICEAP opened their doors for the first time on January 11, 2010. They started with two laptops and a handful of eager students ready to start their academic careers. Now they are making a home for themselves at the Morrison Campus in Glace Bay.

The Morrison building (named after the former Glace Bay mayor Dan Willie Morrison) was opened in 1947 as a high school. The building remained a high school, with many additions built on, until 1989 when it switched to house junior

high students. Morrison Junior High School operated until 2010



when construction of another junior high building was completed to amalgamate three schools in the area.

ICEAP bought the building from the Cape Breton-Victoria Regional School Board and proceeded with extensive renova-

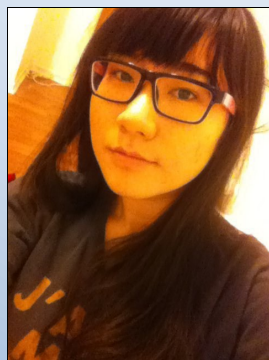
tions. The new school was opened to students for classes in September 2011.
